Just mark it on the back (please put me on file). When we resume it will be with new patterns so please don't start any new garments for now.

Up to now the project has been an emotional journey with many ups and downs.. We have laughed and cried together many times, picked each other up out of the doldrums when things become daunting and rejoiced together when things are going well. So please let us take this break recharge the batteries ready for another attempt to help the Vulnerable Children of the World.

Sent to date....well over 230,000 jumpers plus thousands and thousands of dolls and hats and they are still pouring in. Please forgive us if from now on we don't acknowledge your parcels they all arrive safely and we haven't lost one yet. It becomes expensive and time consuming and we do need to keep costs down.
